



Instructions for Paper Submission to ARMA Golden 2024 Symposium

General

The detailed format requirements and templates (MSWord, LaTeX, LyX and OverLeaf) for ARMA Golden 2024 papers can be found on the symposium website:

All papers will be peer-reviewed by experts in the respective subject areas through an online process, with critical review of the paper by a minimum of two technical reviewers.

Important Dates

February 23, 2024: Deadlines for paper submission

April 12, 2024: Notification to authors

April 26, 2024: Deadline for paper revision

May 10, 2024: Final decisions to authors

May 17, 2024: Deadline for author registration

Full delegate registration by at least one of the authors must be received by 17 May 2024 – Papers for which no delegate payment has been received will not be included in the symposium program.

Unlike recent symposia since Covid, we will not be offering a "no paper" option. In other words, all authors should be intending to attend the symposium. We do, however, understand that unforeseen issues beyond the control of our authors, for example visa delays or denials, can lead to an inability to attend the symposium. Authors who anticipate their ability to attend the symposium and present their work will remain uncertain until the month immediately preceding the symposium should indicate a preference for a "poster" presentation format. Papers assigned to podium presentation slots that have a 'no-show' author without substantial prior notice to ARMA may lead to such papers not being included in the proceedings.

Introduction of Online Paper Submission

Paper submission and review for the ARMA Golden 2024 symposium will be handled on the Conference Management Toolkit (CMT) platform, as it has been for the abstract submission, using the same submission ID for the paper as for the abstract.



Submit a Paper

When you enter the CMT paper submission system, you will see a page titled “Author Console”. On the top bar, from right to left, you will see your registered name, a shorthand name of the conference “ARMA2024”, and your role as an “Author”. If you have agreed to serve as a reviewer or a Meta Reviewer (session convener), you can also switch to other roles by clicking on the respective role button.

To submit a paper, you will need to replace the abstract that was submitted before with the paper (this is to keep the submission ID for abstract and paper) by clicking on “Edit Submission”.

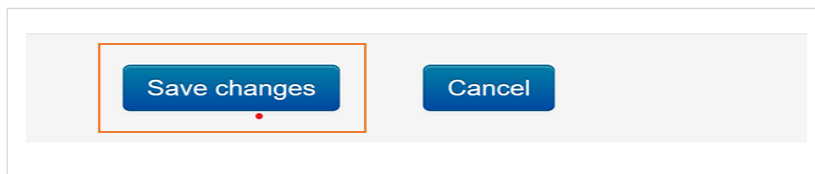
